

Minutes of Croyde Surf Club Committee Meeting

Apologies for absence: Gary Clay confirmed that no apologies had been received.

Club House Update: Gary and Matt confirmed that outline plans for the Club house have been drawn up, along with provisional costs for building and a capital funding strategy along with financial plan for future sustainability.

The committee agreed that in the meantime storage was required CSC equipment/banners etc and the best way ahead for this would be to buy a sign written trailer, which would be more cost efficient than a trailer.

ACTION: Isabelle to contact Mark Kentell, Leisure and Health Officer from NDC to arrange a meeting, Gary and Matt to attend.

CRB Update: Gary confirmed that he has all the CRB forms back and will send them off.

UK PRO SURF SALTROCK Update: Gary waiting for Dave Reed the organiser of the UK PRO to return to work after breaking his leg.....watch this space for an update.

Funding Update: The Devon Community Fund should be confirmed/denied by the end of this month. The application for the rescue tubes and one rescue board has been refused. Sport England application for trailer and 10 soft boards to be submitted.

The committee discussed whether to use the Micah Lester money to progress the NARS applications as the grant has not been confirmed yet and it was felt that the club needs the qualified volunteers for the Monday night sessions soonest.

ACTION: Isabelle to re-submit application for rescue tubes etc, also submit Sport England application for trailer and soft boards.

Isabelle to submit NARS applications for Matt Knight, Gemima Knight, Beau Bromham and Rob Whitney.

Charity Status: The Committee decided to put the charity application on hold until we hear about planning permission for Club House.

Update on Sponsorship/Marketing: No update as yet.

ACTION: Gary to remind/chase up Andy Milne.

BSA Tiki Interclub's 2/3 October: Matt confirmed that RED BULL have agreed to sponsor this years Interclub's, (see proposal attached) and that BSA have confirmed that they will sponsor CSC to the value £500.

ACTION: Rob Tibbles to design poster.

2010 Watersports Games, Spain: Rob Whitney and Andy Cotton have selected the North Devon Team and will be contacting the individuals concerned during the week. Congratulations to those who made the team.

ACTION: Rob and Cotty to confirm team on CSC Website.

Goldcoast After Party: Matt Knight confirmed that he would be organising a Members Only After Party , this will help increase membership and revenue. The party will be held on Friday 18th June, it will be advertised on the CSC Website.

AOP, EOP and Risk Assessment to be on view.

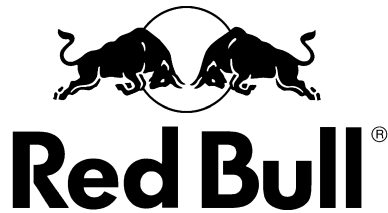

Red Bull Event Vehicle

The Event Vehicle will be used to create ambient music throughout the day and help with the commentary of the event through its wireless microphone. It is proposed that the Event Vehicle will be positioned in the following locations; on the beach subject to council approval or adjacent to the judging area and in the evening situated in the marquee for the party.

Red Bull Stock

Red Bull will provide enough product to sample all the competitors and staff.

Red Bull Bar

Red Bull will supply a bespoke bar which will be positioned in the marquee. This should be used by the BSA Tiki Interclub's help maximise sales from the party. BSA Tiki Interclub's have to manage and run the bar. Red Bull will provide Point Of Sale.
